Rabbi Rosen will address the reality of anti-Semitism; and how the charge of anti-Semitism is used to repress support of Palestinian liberation struggles. Rosen warns that safety and security for Jews “will not come by throwing in with the oppressors; it can only come through solidarity with the oppressed.”

Rabbi Rosen is a congregational rabbi at Tzedek Chicago, Midwest Regional Director of the American Friends Service Committee, co-founder of Jewish Voice for Peace Rabbinical Council, and author of “Wrestling in the Daylight: A Rabbi’s Path to Palestinian Solidarity.” He is also a contributor to the JVP anthology “On Anti-Semitism Solidarity and the Struggle for Justice.” Rabbi Rosen’s blog: Shalom Rav (<http://rabbibrant.com> )
